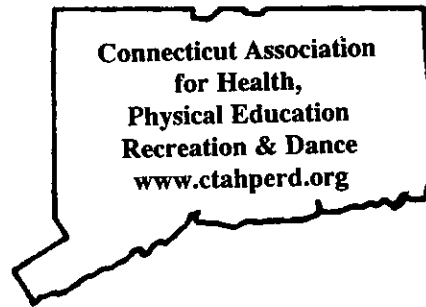


Dear Stu,
